

Sunday 27 July 1890
Hebron remarks & sermon on St Mark
part of 10 C by B. C. D. Nighswander
U. Drudges Messrs Stover & Johnson
Kamers were here to dinner W. fine
28 Boys finished cutting wheat at other
place except low ground & began cutting
barley in east part of field east of den
& Susanna went to Merkhams
Boys finished cutting barley P.M. fine
29 Boys cut I went at home except
low places where we sowed spring wheat
it seems to be filling pretty well
W. fine warm I & A. & Henry drove
in hay out of meeting house yard &
swaid at other place & took 9 Bus
Pears & Barley Chaf to B. So this evening
30 I & H mowed some barley in stump
field at other place & I cut few acres
in field behind barn next bushpit was
short) with Mowing Machine A.M.
Chored & shelled Corn P.M. W.
fine & warm A.M. slow rain P.M.
boys brought home Chaf after supper
31 I cut barley for P.D. all day I & H. cut
fall wheat in rough ground at other place
& finished whitewashing kitchen at east end
& fixed hearth. W. warm slight shower at noon

August 1st 1890
I & H began to cut barley at other
place with old reaper cut well but the
best part of grain which as yet they cut
till noon with scythes I & Susanna
went to Merkhams A.M. I went to W.
Armstrongs barn raising & we drove in
short loose barley out of field behind
barn P.M. killed 3 Pigs after supper
& H took them to Cakwells @ \$6.00
P.M. fine warm & clear
2 I & H finished cutting barley at other
place with old reaper A.M. we drove
in loads with 2 teams P.M.
W. fine warm clear
Sunday 3 at home all day young folks
went to B. Co. W. the warmest day this
season, a fine shower & some thunder the
evening
4 Boys had temp second time I & Mary
went to Mannasin Fort; while P.M.
his wife is poorly I & A brought dressed
lumber from D. Ramin & took 4 bags
barley to B. So W. very warm heavy
shower & some thunder P.M.
5 Boys chored & began ganging barley stubble
behind barn heavy shower stopped them A.M.
