tongue he got at Chapmans on Thursday  
 got in place of it 30 lbs binder twine at 130<sup>ts</sup>  
 & 6.50 also took 75<sup>ts</sup> oil 5<sup>ts</sup> paid balance 4.30  
 We put new keels on binder and started to  
 cut more barley in No 4 about 10 AM  
 Hood turned it while then. The binder  
 does not work well and about 6 PM the  
 horizontal canvas broke and we had to quit  
 without finishing the barley. Willie drove  
 Mary down at night - she stayed down he  
 got at Simpson bread 14<sup>ts</sup> costing for binder  
 at Chapmans 30<sup>ts</sup>
