 Sunday Aug 1 at home all day D & I were here W. fine Clear
 2 B & C cut our fall wheat with his Burdick Reaper. it works
 Splendid we got it all bound & more than half shocked W fine
 Cool. I worked all day with my vest on
 3 I killed a calf Joe sawed some wood Am. I went to Markham
 & Joe shocked last of wheat Pm. W. some drizzle rain
 4 hoad some turnip second time Am I & Joe & Flavins helped
 B & C bind wheat Pm. W. Cloudy Am. Close Pm
 5 hoad turnip Joe went to Markham after supper W. Cloudy
 Am. fine rain Pm. fine growing weather

August 1875
 6 hoad a few ^{turnip} Joe piled Pea straw deny behind old barn
 between showers. W. about 7 showers through. The deny ^{was} ^{cut} ^{out} ^{from} ^{the} ^{stubble} ^{and} ^{cached}
 7 Cleaned a grist this morning then I took it to P. Hoover's Am & cut
 road round barley Pm. Joe harrowed fallow. W. rather Cloudy
 Sunday & I & Nany went to Meeting at Cedar Grove
 Sermons by B & C. Sermon on ^{by} ^{Rev} ^H
 Borky. Uncle Sam's Resoir was here Pm. W. fine Clear
 9 I Joe & Flavins helped B & C finish cutting wheat Am
 began cutting our barley with old Machine Pm cuts well
 little John drove & I raked off McGraw & R W helped a
 few hours. we are binding it. W. fine
 10 Finished cutting & binding & shocking barley till 10 Am
 then drew 1 load of wheat till noon & 8 loads Pm W. Clear
 11 Finished drawing in wheat 12 loads. W. warm looks like
 rain Nany & boys were visiting at B's. No yesterday & at B's
 12 I took grist Oat Chop to Cedar Grove Mills Am I & little boys
 hoad turnip till supper Joe harrowed fallow till supper
 little John raked wheat stubble from about 11 Am till
 supper then we drew in rakes after supper W. fine
