

April 1889

- 1 Monday, I borrowed \$6⁰⁰ from Auntie to send to Murdy, with 11⁰⁰ we had 16⁰⁰
This has been a very fine day, The G. Templar are having a tuffy party tonight
- 2 I am pretty tired after last night, Jimmie gave 1 gull syrup to the party, sold two
- 3 Got 1/2 gull ~~syrup~~ oil 13. paid for the butter and coal oil that was charged - 57 + 13 = 70 - 70
We heard in the papers that there was a hurricane on the coast of Simoa and 3 American Men of War, and three German Men of War wrecked and a number of the crews perished
- 4 I was not at prayer meeting last night Womens Meeting at 7⁰⁰ A.M. I had no offering paid 10 cts to Mrs McLaurin for dinners to North West children 10
- 5 Sent a letter to Murdy and \$15⁰⁰ for fees 15
- 6 We are boiling some syrup very slow
- 7 I was very unwell last night and went early to bed Not many to church Marion paid 10 cts for Point T. scholar
- 8 Fine day, Jimmie went to the bush at midnight and began to boil
- 9 I made sugar on Saturday & Monday and today 98 lb in all Perry helped calf on the 9th
- 10 Anniversary of our Marriage. Fine day too warm for sup. Davy Taylor, died this morning Jimmie pants 2.84 at Wallie
- 11 Taylor buried this afternoon. Far went to Lun deaster tonight to go Montreal tomorrow
- 12 Jimmie boiled something today it does not look very nice I washed, got at 11⁰⁰ 2 lb granulated sugar charged 22
- 13 Cold & raw, got 1/2 bush salt
