1918 It was quite nice I ploughed at the corn ground Fred had a sore hand Fred & Ray went to Spencerill to see the Doctor I went over to prayer meeting

WEDNESDAY 29

(149-216)

It was quite nice we fixed Archie fence down on the lower place in the forenoon and picked chunks of the new land in the afternoon 1918 It was quite a warm day I finished ploughing the garden corn ground & sheared 4 sheep
