- 19 Snowed this morning but not enough for sleighing. about 8 o'clock P.M. turned to rain. Dr. Falkner & son. took dinner with us
- 20 Very cold today. Harry left the G. Temple last night. he had been drinking Cider at Sullivan got 1/2 gall coal oil 13cts. Brought home Solly & the coats. Trying to finish boiling soap
- 21 Had to put the soap into the cellar. Sold 1550 lb hay to the mms. \$7.50. I kept 1.50. gave 50 to Run for skulls. Jimmie got a pair at J.A's 50
- 22 Very cold weather. the river is frozen enough to skate on since Monday 19th Dr. Falkner has moved his family into the Kentail House today. Birdie went to the Branch School today to teach the promotion. Hatty is in the Glen Jimmie has a bad cold. got 1 bottle T.C. Oil - 20 cts 20
- 23 Cold day. Hatty was here. Far. Ewen. Hugh took her away after tea To mailing promotion papers <sup>was Hatty's</sup> 5
- 24 Not so cold. looks like snow. Birdie made a pork cake. 1 lb pork cut very fine 1/2 pint boiling water pour onto the pork 1 cup molasses. 1 tea spoon soda. put into the molasses. 2 cups sugar 1 tea spoon ginger 1 lb raisin. 1 oz cinnamon 1 oz cloves 1 oz nutmeg.
