Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> fine

Father & I went to Church  
in morning. & Children  
& I in afternoon to S.S.  
Col. 30. 04, 10,

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> Showery  
We finished sowing rape  
behind bush peter scaffling  
mangels & hoeing Charlie  
X took Princess to <sup>she took hops & later</sup> Sorby's in morning  
& went to mill in afternoon  
brought home corn chop and  
took 180 <sup>lb</sup> Barley and  
Rye. Mother got home. Bessie mountain called today

Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> fine  
We started to cut hay today  
cut about 3 1/2 acres & kiled it  
in evening. Father & I hoeing mangels  
till about teatime.

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> frost  
We hoed mangels in morning  
and fixed things around  
barn. then hoed in afternoon  
I also went to see about getting  
things fixed.

Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> fine  
We hoed & scaffled roots  
most of day. Started to hoe  
Turnips. went to mill in  
Evening got 450 <sup>lb</sup> Chop at 10<sup>00</sup> P.  
got quart of chop. • 70<sup>c</sup> 70  
but wiggle came & fixed things  
I got rope from him \$7<sup>82</sup> 46<sup>00</sup> at 11<sup>00</sup> P. 782

Friday 8<sup>th</sup> fine  
We hoed turnips and mowed  
some hay in morning and  
5 hauled 5 loads in afternoon  
& G. & Hood had Hereford cow to E.P. Master

Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> Showery  
1 We hauled 1 ball of hay in  
morning & kiled up most  
of what we had cut.
