spend the evening.") Charles got home
on the late train which was not very
late and got in about 10 p.m. Slept
outside - quite fresh.

February 4
(Wednesday) Was cold when I went to bed and so
did not get warmed up - consequently
did not sleep much. Wakened or
rather startled by fire Bell. Hearing
from Central it was Ross & Warming's
Gent's Furnishing Store and a bad fire.
I got ready & went down so Charles
