 West Wind Frosty Drawing and Cutting Willows
 7th very Windy Cold 8th Cold Freezing high Wind
 Princess Louise Went up the Snow
 9th the Princess cropped and went up fine
 some Wind snowing some ice freeze out
 to the Rushes Dredge some Wood
