

Monday 22nd Aug. 1791

Cornelius Lambert finished cutting my summer wheat, hauled & stack'd it about 1/2 days work
7th Oct

Cornelius Lambert cut my Buck wheat (about 2 hours work)
9th Oct

Thos Rice plow'd one day (for wheat)
6th Oct.

Thos Rice & I cleared my 1/2 share of winter wheat with Thos Rice about 5 1/2 bushels
12 & 13th

Sowed 3 1/2 Bushels winter wheat with Elijah Collards team 2 days work & a boy
18th Oct.

M^r Lambert plow'd with his team 1 day & 2 hours in the field facing the door for summer wheat
20th Thursday

The first Snow this fall, it snow'd and drifted till evening 27th

Finished digging Potatoes, had about 30 bushels in all
28th

Pull'd Turnips had only 5 bushels owing to the bad seed I got of M^r Rice
29th

Changed with Mich^l Fleck half a bushel of (lady finger) Potatoes to have yellow in place of them
Nov. 1st

My Wife went to Niagara & sold
1 doz Fowls for 1-7-0
3 bats for 4 Quarts salt 4-00
4 doz Eggs 2/6 10-0

Nov. 1st 1791

Paid Joseph Edwards account 1-17-
Bought 4 1/2 Yd Linen 18-
2 Yd. Brown Coating 1-
Cash from Edwards for Ferryage 1-

11th Nov.

Kill'd three Pigs . . . weight 94^{lbs}

19th

Weighed & stem'd part of my Tobacco 57 Rollo wt. 16^{lbs} 2
do - do 9

Dec.

Kill'd a Pig weight 19 -

3 Pairs Shoes made by Elijah Collard from the Feb^{ry} to Dec.

Dec. 22nd

Took up my Note for £ 4. 4. 0 to Elijah Phelps and gave Homes Brightman an order on David Secord Sen^r for the amount for which I stand indebted to him. David Secord
