- 3 drew dung the same I worked at the hosing ^{road}
- 4 thrashed the barley & cleaned had 4 bushel in the ^{grain}
- 5 Bin over 100 bunt bottoms it works well works at the hosing finished ours & some of Jacks fine day all together finished Jacks this morning over 2000 went to the Funeral of John Miller he died on wednesday he was buried at the Stone church the Rev W Bell preached the church could not hold all that was there the roads is very bad
- 7 Split a few rails on the line between Jack & me blow the anchor down went to Longmead & fishing got some pike went to Cauntown & heard the Rev W McKenney preach in afternoon fine day after the rain
- 9 worked at the rails & bunts fine day went to mill with 15 bushel of oats that was bought of W B Doves I worked at a drag for John Jones
- 10 worked at the line fence saved tried to place it crestes but could not the frost was in the roads he had to quit the boys made bunts
- 12 washed putting up the line fence on the second field fine day
- 13 made a fence on the side of the 2 acres next the East line
