James Cameron Island 2<sup>nd</sup> of October  
 this or last night is old Hallbore  
 Raining East Wind kind of Foggy  
 my sight is very dim I can hardly  
 make out to see to write a lot  
 of shooting this morning snowed  
 to night Fernandez came from Dougl  
 Cracked Butternuts to night some Windy  
 13<sup>th</sup> Lots of snow on the ground kind  
 foggy sun shining Windy snowed  
 to night quite a lot Stanley Plastering he  
 is about the Cattle and Poultry Windy  
 14<sup>th</sup> Snowing Windy Drifting Stanley  
 Fixing around the Barnyard some cold  
 a Fortunate Day Working at the  
 Kitchen cellar Door and steps in cellar  
 Navigation still open to night  
 did not Milk the cows 15<sup>th</sup> Fine  
 not much Wind one of the Kittens  
 came last night to the House from  
 the Bush and another to Day shot  
 4 Ducks on the Little Island Brew  
 a Load of Strain to the outside cellar  
 Door shutting it up for the Winter  
 quite a lot of snow fell Working  
 at the cellar Door banking some ferns  
 crossed 4 Ducks with rum some  
 came had the Concan for the stove pipe  
 hole cool 16<sup>th</sup> Cool Lots of Boats going up  
 to Day Stanley Working around the Cattle  
 and Stables, Filgate went up 17<sup>th</sup> Fine  
 St. Hugh's Day Leander came Gordon  
 came Ed Kenshaw got a Butcher knife  
 Leander brought a Square Butter Box the first  
 I have seen of the kind took a Jenner to  
 Douquet of Butter and a Crock to Adeliade

The Harrest Month of Death 1901

James Cameron Island 18 of November  
 Fine one of the sea Sea Boats went  
 Down this morning Eddy here took  
 up some traps Barges and Dredges are  
 Yowed up snowed some Stanley to the store  
 Bought 25<sup>ll</sup> of Flour 50 Sea 25 Cinnamon 10  
 Soda 5 Matches 12 cough drops Candy found  
 a Butter Jenner 19<sup>th</sup> Fernandez came got a  
 Letter from Dan and sent one off to him  
 Randolph here Eddy took down the Letter  
 Killing Lots of Chickens took the Letter over  
 to night 20<sup>th</sup> A fortunate Day Fine cool  
 Froze last night Randolph here the Boat  
 Yaken Stones from Mr. McLaughlin to  
 Lighthouse at Lancaster Shelled about  
 11 Bushels of Corn to night Froz to night  
 Removed the old pig pen took over  
 Corn 21<sup>st</sup> Unfortunate Day on this  
 Day of the Month I would master  
 Senior I departed 1846 a Fine Day  
 put the vinegar to the cellar The  
 Alexandra went down this Morning  
 got the cat in the trap one of the old  
 Jones let out the 2 Rooms last night  
 22<sup>nd</sup> St Cecilia's Day Fine Stanley  
 putting more Banking on the Cellar Door  
 Killing the Chickens Stanley putting  
 manure around the apple trees took over  
 9 Yraces of corn The Alexandra went  
 up and only went down yesterday snow  
 melting Water Low an Dull and Smoky  
 foggy Shelled a Bushel of corn to night  
 Windy to night Froze some sight up get  
 23<sup>rd</sup> St Clement's Day Fine Fair  
 Frosty Dredge went up & Wind Lots of Boats to Day  
 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday Windy East Leander and Eddy to supper  
 Island got 3 Ducks Rained to night
