 Mon 10 Ann 65 Flora Christie was here all day she ironed the washing
 Tues 11 Got ¹⁰⁷⁰ 8 bunches of shingles 41.30 = 336 cartage 1.50 = 37.50

 Wed 12 Gordons began to shingle the old Post Office I gave Jimmie a cheque on Mr Bank for \$ 60.00 = 60
 settled with Jimmie today
 Thurs 13 2 loaves 18 did not work today

 Sat 15 Gordons finished the shingling took two days 70 milk 42 bread 27 coal oil 25
 Sun 16 General fund 25. Fine day
 Mon 17 Lovely morning Jimmie met a man at 7. A.M. and took him in car, to see the wood
 Tues 18 Ann in afternoon mopped plucked two cockerels 75, molasses 40, 3 loaves 27 do 142
 I baked a few pies

Wed 19 First day of the Fair I had no callers It is a very fine day. Stuffed the three cockerels and roasted them
 Thurs 20 Dull and looks like rain Jimmie did not come home to dinner, only Agnes and I to dinner Murdy came about 3 o'clock
 Farquhar Jean and Glydis came about 7.30
 I went with them to the Fair ground ^{myself} Jean or I got out of the car, The rain kept off all day
 Frid 21 I am resting, John P. brought a piece of pork
 Sat 22 Milk 42, bread 36 78
 Sun 23 Missions \$2.00, General fund 25, Mrs Christie 2.25 and Flora Ann were here, they were down with Joan and Bella Heavy frost last night
 Mon 24 Fine day. I pulled some beans 18
 " 2 loaves 18
 Tues 25 Finished pulling the beans. Murdy and Agnes took them in, pulled some corn, Jimmie bunched the buckwheat
 Wed 26 Farquhar and Jean came by car and I went with them to South Lancaster to see Lillian and Joan, 70 3 loaves 27, coarse salt 15 matches 5 27
 Thurs 27 Fine day I am cleaning beans 20
 Frid 28 coal oil 25 - Jimmie I paid Jimmie 25 on 4th Oct, 25
 Sat 29 Milk 42, bread 18 18
 Sun 30 I sent no offering
