 thimble 75 cts. Mary down home all night

25 Sunday  
 Christmas Day. Frosty. cold east wind.  
 Mr McVicar preached in A.M. from  
 Luke 2:10. and in evening from Luke 2:28.  
 Church collection \$5.00

26 Monday  
 chilly misty rainy day cold east wind.  
 trees covered with mist. We all drove  
 down home for dinner Uncle Jim  
 and Mrs Ritchie there for dinner.  
 Wm Shatnood in in P.M. bought  
 Patience at \$350 per cart to go in two weeks  
 Received on her \$1.00 "Sandy" Barnet died yesterday.

27 Tuesday

 less all day trees and everything all  
 covered with ice bearing the trees down.
