We went to the League Rally tonight. Ruth Schmidt won the oratorical contest. Laura Miller & Irvon Schmeider also spoke. Rev. G. Epp of Cleveland, Ohio gave an excellent address.

31 Monday. Fair and milder. Walter helped finish Elmo's threshing this morning. Vernon plowed. Elam Weber and his brother were our callers tonight.
