Cloudy day. raining last night thawing a lot to-day water running in streams. got very windy in P.M. and frosty snowing some. I split wood in A.M. and in P.M. Willie drove me to upper bridge then I went out of way to James Dick's sale with Fred Rowley & son. came back with them. Willie drove mother to Hospital to see Frank, also drove Bella to dentist get teeth filled she got stamp 2 cts. Mr. Saw over at night got 1/2 milk can

Cold. stormy, some sunshine. I finished splitting wood in woodshed A.M. Willie made small whalbanow to hand Thompson. In P.M. We cleaned seed oats etc. Sheep had a lamb to-day saw eat so much of it had to kill it. Bella made cloth holder for bits etc to night.
