MEXICO FACES DAMAGE CLAIMS

Canadian Business Men Demand \$12,000,000
Reparation

Claims totalling \$12,000,000 have been made by Canadian investors and companies in Mexico, on account of damages suffered during the recent disturbances. The claim of Canadian investors is part of a total of \$91,000,000 asked of the present Mexican Government by domestic and foreign investors in that country. Mexicans are asking \$40,000,000, Spaniards \$24,000,000 and English companies \$4,600,000.

Using Wireless To Send Stock Reports

A further development in the progress of Marconi wireless is reported from London, England. Under an arrangement with a Dutch concern—the Nederlandsche Seintoestellen Fabriek—the English Marconi Company has installed one of its latest types of wireless telephone transmitters in the stock exchange, Amsterdam, and has also equipped, with Marconi wireless receivers, some fifty bankers' offices throughout Holland. By means of this system, exchange reports are promptly transmitted to the principal Dutch banks. The service has been in operation only for a short period, but reports from the bankers concerned indicate that it is entirely successful and arrangements are now being made for its extension to many of the other banks not now included in the "wireless" network.
