- June 17 Friday. doing chores. & thinning turnips in orchard. very warm. cloudy.
- June 18 Saturday. doing chores. hoeing turnips in orchard. & cutting grass around trees. Recd letter from H.E.P.
- June 19 Sunday. doing chores. drove to R. & had TD with H.E.P. Mr & Mrs Stewart there else. Miss S.G.P. went over with me. I over at Frank Barlows talking with S.G.P. & Mrs Barlow. also went for walk with S.G.P. very warm.
- June 20 Monday. doing chores. took milk to factory. 248 lbs. cultivating turnips & mangles very warm. got first milk check from F.W.M. \$14.01 = cheese 29¢.
- June 21 Tuesday. doing chores. took milk to factory. 235 lbs. started to thin mangles. very warm. settled with F.W.M. for barley. chopping. milk checks. & balance due me on turnipseed. \$8.31 = Paid him \$7.00 cash \$1.31 due him.
- June 22 Wednesday. doing chores. took milk to factory & thinning turnips all day. had words with F.W.M. about settlement. & things in general. very warm.
- June 23 Thursday. doing chores. took milk to factory & hocking mangles. & potatoes.
