and I got mine yesterday Hand frost not
Kunung got some Windy 3rd Rory and
Donald John came across and Jim and
Willie went across with them took
over one of their Cakes 11th wind high
Ice Jamming before the Door 4th cutting
Brush in the upper field for the Court Windy
spending Blustering 5th cutting Brush Windy
June 1st Bowling them in the Bush freezing
6th McHugh Jim went off stoft with
J. Mc Dougall to night the Rev. Sir Watsons
Daughter D. departed 7th Draining Manure
to the Lower Point North side 8th Cropped
with J. Mc Dougall to the Fort of Koonung
Island as he is going to Miss Watsons funeral
Buried her before the Door J. Hamilton
in Cornival (Bought Mr Ward
100 lb of Flour Bought Mc Cants of Crimg Pastor part
Bought of J. Summers July 5 cents pipe
got a Plate Down from the Koonung
Up Running well fine Day Great
Jamming of Ice going Down a Box Pine
Nell Drive on the Head of the Island with
the force of the Ice Tom Back getting over
the Measels 5th on this Day of the Month
was cleared 1862 15 yds to Day sap running
well sugaring 6 lbs to Day Raising Beet factory
came 7th in Hamiltons Randolph and I took
a cap in my coat put it up in the
sugar Bush

Bowling Rory and Willie and the Box
a fine Day Ice going Down ice in
a Lam 11th sugaring of to Day all Day
Began to snow very Blustering
turned fine Brought one of
paper Collin Dougal the witness
12th sugaring to Day took all their sugar
home 13th ^{Buck commenced to lay} Willie
here with Dan Americk Boat as he was
to Salmon River tomorrow Peter Back had
stoft all night fishing 2^{lb} something
at the hens I fired a shot Back
of the Barn to frighten the Fox
as he is left on the Island 15th
Good Friday Peter Back went of
J. Dougal and Willie went to
Fort Carrington cropped over to Miss
on the south side and walked up
as it is much shorter a fine Day
Randolph took the handle from the
Bush that Rory made me
yesterday ^{mine} spelling high South W
Wind calm I took the Brambling
out of the cook house put in
the worn Boxes Breading some
of the Ice close to shore Drove
the Bun out of the ice on
the Bank made Mc Cants Jim Dougal and
Willie took it across and Rory cropped
alone 16th no one in the Bush to Day
sap running I took up the ashes
Bismarck and to the head of the Island
seen where the Fox killed a Goose
Randolph ploughed a few rounds set
five to some of the Marsh seen a Crane for the
first set 12 y raps Randolph fixing his canoe
killed 3 snakes this week on the 14th
