today Walt not well. Mrs. J. Binder  
& Mrs. Dan Rose here for dinner.  
Uncle Will brought the bobsleighs  
home which he had to get cold.

Raining today poorly. sleighing Walt  
& I went to Odessa. When I came home cut  
shirt for Fred Binder, I getting to take.

Jan 9 Thursday.

Fine Walt took old hog down to Fred Ladley  
got a cold liver for her. Wilmett to school  
Piclar Ashtree teacher.

Jan 10 Friday.

Walt fixing horse stable, Mrs Quinter & wife down to Charley Rose's for dinner - than to Edna. He got letter from Fred. I did big day's work baked pie and did a good deal of cleaning. We all went up to Wilton to hear G. R. White.

Jan. 11 Saturday.

Frank Collins & wife children & his mother here all day. Benjamin & Almina half fatigued snowed a little.

Sunday. Jan. 12.

Very rough day. W C & I went to Derby. went to  
~~to~~ church at night.

Monday. Jan. 13.

We all went out to see Uncle William Bruege who is dying with Cancer. we stayed for dinner than came home by napance. Fred will get sick when we got home.

Tuesday 14 Jan.

Friy this morning MacLean here just called

for dinner. I churned did not do much. Walt  
worked at Stables. Adney Ball was here for while

Sick headache. Aunt Lydia & Uncle  
will down in evening Til Hill's wife  
here for dinner.

Monday 17 Feb.

Fine day. roads bad & to Odessa in after  
noon. Walt came from Benton sick

Tuesday 18 Feb.

Rough. Walt went to odessa. Roads  
bad. M. Day called in after noon.

Wed 19 Feb.

Uncle Will came for me. Aunt Lydia

it Rained (I made a mistake in saying  
Mrs Snider came home yesterday for  
it was today. <sup>fire in kitchen</sup>

I took Emma Rose home after noon

Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup>.

I up to Aunt Lydia's all day she  
very poorly. Mrs Snider did her  
washing Wilmette to school. <sup>fire in kitchen</sup>

Wed. 26<sup>th</sup>

Fine Mrs Snider & I to Odessa in  
afternoon. Mrs Snider got letter  
from Dr. and one from Mrs Cain  
and Photo.

Thursday 27. Feb.

Fine day. I baked cake & pie in kitchen  
tried Bill to Odessa at night we served some  
rainy <sup>windy</sup> over to Mrs. Bills after dinner,  
fire in Kitchen Wilmette home from  
school Roads bad.

Friday 28.

June 1. 1882 Sunday.

Wilmot & Grandma at church &  
Quay school, Walt up to Uncle Will  
he was better. I & Walt up at  
night.

Monday 2. June

Went up to Uncle Wills Esley  
Stayed all day. Dr. Thind they  
from City helped WC set out lot  
of plants chummed.

Tuesday 3. June.

Took Uncle to Hospital (I not feeling well). Went up

to Odessa at night.

Thursday, 5 June.

Potter here from Moscow;  
Went down dining room carpet  
I painted oilcloth helped WC  
plant corn. He finished his potato  
yesterday. We have 75 chickens

Friday, 6 June, 1902

I swept up stairs, we heard  
to day Uncle Will was on  
better his coming home  
tomorrow. Mrs. Smiles up.  
To Alpine Inn for tea  
WC & I up to Aunt Lydia's  
for tea. Fine but looks like  
rain. Sat. June 7th.

Rainy in morning but cleared  
I did yesterday's work and  
up to Alpine Inn they got

him home at six o'clock in  
Evening very tired and weak  
They think there is a cause  
in his stomach but do not  
know. I stayed all night.  
sat up with him poor man  
it is something dreadfull  
how he suffers.

Sunday June 8th.

This day I sat at Grace's  
he put in a hard night. Alice B.  
allance came down. They was  
a good many in. I slept a  
couple of hours in afternoon

Monday 9th.

Alice & I sat up with him  
fearfull night he suffers.  
He seems better today. I came  
down home but they came

after we were less than half  
hour I slept at night. Dr.  
Smith, Dr. Willigard, & Tarius  
sat up. I got up once rainy  
Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup>.

Rainy, Azorile no better,  
I came home 10 o'clock  
with sick headache Mrs.  
Snider <sup>went</sup> down to Libe <sup>windy</sup>  
Walt to Odessa.

Wed. 11<sup>th</sup>.

Petter here from Moscow,  
up to Azorile all day  
came home with Dr. Mabel  
Azorile great deal better  
hopes of him now.

Thursday 12.

Mrs Snider to Yekaterinburg. I help to  
clean in after rooms.  
Rose went home to areaas.

Friday 13th.

I sat up with Uncle alone last night better. came home and helped milk this morning.

Sat. 14 June.

Fri., I not feeling well. Made night shirt for Uncle and  
Darnished furniture in front  
west room Uncle wills in after  
noon. Went to Odessa at night.

Sunday 15-June,

Not well. Mrs. Brink, went  
to church. You and Vicki here  
for tha did not hear from  
Uncle today.

Monday 16 June.

Left to Uncle Will's in after noon  
came home helped milk cows  
back stayed all night, we  
worked in wet patch Uncle  
was restless.

Tuesday 17 June

Came home at half past four  
in morning, Mr. Orme,  
went to Convention at Odessa  
and then down to Lubbock.  
D. came for me in after  
noon. Uncle went much better,  
walk in boots.

Wednesday 18 June.

I started to wash they came  
after me from home. I was  
up till twelve Uncle well

went not so well, Rose came out.  
Mrs. Foster down for some  
rubarb. Walt. Ashland  
shut today. Mrs. Onidus  
came home tonight brought  
a box of strawberries.  
W.C & I at Odessa.  
Sick day.

Wilmett sick, did not go to school  
did not have his cloths on all day.

I did my work in morning AM  
& Mrs. Powley came after dinner,  
I called up to Uncle Wills he no  
better, very cold weather. Willie  
Ballance stayed here all night  
W.C. went to Odessa.

Sunday. 22 June.

Powleys here all day. Willie  
stayed for breakfast. Muriel  
Bridges here for a call, rough cold  
day. L.L. & Fred here for tea.

Monday 23 June.

Mrs. Mrs. Powley went out to Yons.  
I went up to Uncle Wills stayed all  
day. W.C. went to drill in afternoon  
and up to Uncle Wills all night  
he no better today W.C. took

Tuesday, 24 June.

I washed, fine day. Skinned  
milk, cleaned floors and Stove  
pipes, Mr and Mrs. Porley called  
on way home this morning, I  
up to Sand Hill saw him  
he was better. D. J. Smith those  
wrote to Odessa. we have not heard  
from Mrs. Odessa Wilcox not well

Wednesday, 25 June

Fine heard from Mrs. Odessa last  
night. Very better, a 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  month  
old baby. I took a walk down  
to Dr. Lee's office, Smith  
said he is rundown. I up  
to Uncle Bill when I came  
back they expect a man  
to nurse him down home  
churned. helped wash clothes

and fresh land or seemed  
a little easier Dr. cause  
said it was Romania  
he raised blood and his  
nose fled. seems better  
tonight Emma Rose  
came down helped cause

3 boxes of strawberries

Mrs J. Orde went home  
tonight. I sat up till  
three in morning then  
we got up. Mrs J. Foster

Sunday 29 June

Walworth set two traps  
the same and Lydia had  
a few minutes Mrs Clark  
also Walworth caught her  
very hard all night

Monday 30 June

Rainy Dr here. Wilcox  
no letter, then 100) said  
bad wet day for us.

Walt working at barn.

to him for 7 o'clock train

Tuesday 15 - July

Walt & H. Hill went to  
Carrington with hogs  
to ship at 6<sup>th</sup> C. live weight  
I washed buggy & wagon  
Thunderay to day yet we  
& Fred Hill to Odessa  
at night.

Fine I washed buggy & car all  
day. Cleaned wood house.  
Walt & Wilmet down to Cops

got some for ducks. Fred

afternoon; Men worked in hay  
over hill till noon. I cut out  
black shirt for a coll. A.C.  
to Odessa. I up to Uncle Wills  
in coll. Sunday. 20.

Rainy, did not go any where  
Till wife out to her father's,

Monday 20

Bainey Wall & I to Napsauce  
walked up to Philander  
after we came home H. Niles  
and wife to Odessa he sick  
all day.

Tuesday, 21 July

I washed in morning then  
Libbie & Miss Addie here all  
day. Wall & I had worked in  
hay over hill.

Wed., 23. July.

This till evening till night  
then it rained men worked  
over hill in hay and we  
women milked I picked  
black currants.

Thursday 24 July

I did usual work. Frank  
picked some raspberry berries.  
Went to Odessa in aft.  
noon. got letter from Mrs.  
Snider called on Mary.  
Snider's that used to be  
called on Mrs C Jones.  
she has young son.  
4 Hill to Napavine for  
shingles. Walt cut hay  
in front of house. I  
put shoes on pony,  
and Goldie.

Friday 25 -.

Time Walt cut hay next to Lewis'  
motel. Snider, + Wilson went  
to Odessa to take a letter  
for Mr. H. G. Co.

Tried to draw hay from  
front of house. pulled a sled  
behind barn, fine.

Sat. 26 July.

Time looks like rain even  
draw hay from rear. Not many.  
~~We~~ went up to Mrs. Clarke's  
& then down to Emma  
Roses for her. He came home  
with Charley on buck wagon  
and went to ~~4~~ actors.  
~~We~~ Hill & wife away. We  
to Odessa.

Sunday. 27 July

We were home all day till night  
then went out to Zions after her  
fin.

Monday 28th.

This Cows got in garden and did lot of damage & Bill cut clover we hill Walt worked in shop a while then went to help Fred up hill worked all day up there till night then went to Odessa. Mrs J. Drinker came home with him from town Saturday afternoon

Wednesday 29th

This I got up 4 o'clock. Put away 30 boxes of berries Washed made bread Ticed Mrs J put a blister on her knee. Eric worked in hay from of dairy house. Hot day.

Wednesday, 30

Some shopping going to at Bath  
today hot day. I put away  
4 cans of red berries from  
our bushes, Mrs. Snodgrass  
rose batter. Wilmett got  
Sherry six times today  
W.C. & Fred Hill worked at  
Thursday, 31 C. 2 hay.

fine hot day. cans of onions  
& I sewed all day. Mrs. Hill  
baked bread. Mrs. A.C.  
to Odessa at night.  
Friday

August Friday 1<sup>st</sup>,  
Hive dry. I have worked from  
driv house at least w C Dix.  
I still worked at hay over hill  
I swept up stains. picked berries,  
took Mrs. J. Winder to Okissa  
at night. went to see Mrs.  
Caulder about doing some  
sewing.

August Sat. 2. AM.  
Hive ended in hay and helped  
w C in after noon w C to address  
at night. Up to aunt Lydia's  
in afternoon.

Aug. Sun. 3. AM.  
Up to Wilson's to church did not  
have Q.R. today. A heavy storm  
after we came home.

Aug. mon 4<sup>th</sup>

This morn drew hay from behind  
mill. I washed cleaned woodhouse  
Mabel brought our mail from  
Office got a letter from Father  
W.C. Gardner went to Station  
for Mrs. Snider; Mrs Snider  
came home very tired and sick.

Tuesday 5 - Aug.

I did not do much today.  
picked berries did them up  
went to Dresser. Mrs Snider's  
S.S. I took dress to Mrs Caulder,  
to have made. rained just a  
little morn working over hill  
bring in Alsch. Cloves.

Wed. 6 Aug.

This I did usual work Mrs Snider  
sick morn worked over hill Fred & his  
sick. W.C. cut barley on hill.

Thursday 7 Aug. 1902.

Picked the last of black currants  
Cut waist in sky. Left W.C. & Fred  
walked over hill putting up barley  
and brought some down. brought  
in sled hay. W.C. to Odessa  
at night & sent some cucumbers  
to Odessa had them for about  
two weeks. lots of ripe apples  
this year. Fine day.

Friday 8. Aug. 1902.

~~Spent~~ ~~Spent~~ drew barley for  
list Mrs. Smidt & I to Odessa  
I to try on dress. got 16 lbs  
of honey looked like rain at  
night. Men thrashed clover  
at C & I went out to town  
and get fairing mill.

Qat. 9 aug.

Worked till noon. Then W.C.  
Wilmot & I went to Kingston  
went to Dr. had Wilmot's  
throat examined. came home  
Tried out it is cornavirus  
Day.

Sunday 10 aug

Looked like rain so did not  
go to church Turned over  
fin.

Monday 11 Aug

W.C. took fairing mill home  
then went to Earmestown  
for Mrs. Cain but she  
did not come So we went  
at night and got her  
and two children

Tuesday, 12. Aug.

Did not do much today  
Mrs Cain very tired she is a  
very fine woman I like her well  
as far as I know. Her  
fine day I ran worked on

Gine & Fred Sniders not very well Fred went over to ~~home~~

came home shortly after.

Fred & Lib came to cans  
home after the Took Mabel  
Snider home with them

Friday 15 - Aug.

We all but W.C. went <sup>marking</sup> ~~down~~ <sup>up</sup> doors to  
to Fred Sniders for the day  
Mr. & Mrs. Pritchard was there  
from Pauses five day but cool

Sat 16 Aug.

Gine slightly shovels night  
now mending in hay <sup>was cold</sup>  
of flats Mrs. Cain and

to Edessa. got my dress that

Sunday, 17 Aug.

Rained a little shower. Mrs. Snider & Mrs. Cain to Winton to church Mr. McCall preached from Odessa.

WC & I did not go anywhere. Mr. & Mrs. Hill out to South WC & I milked all cows.

Monday, 18 Aug.

Rainy. Mrs. Snider took Mrs. Cain & children to Abilene, WC & Wilma went down and bought flour from Mr. Avery. WC & Mr. J. H. Snider went out collecting for church.
