 His wages came to \$13.95
 Thomas Buchan came
 today from Emigration Office Dorset
 & I have pired him for a month
 at \$15⁰⁰ to start with. Mr Morris
 was here all day helping us. at
 hay

Friday 22nd fair
 Tom & his man came along
 this morning and helped
 us to hoe turnips. we hauled
 3 loads of hay & kiled what
 I cut in morning

Saturday 23rd fast
 we chored & scuffled and
 hoed turnips. I went
 to town in morning by 10⁰⁰
 Swine, from Puffelds. 50 B.P. 14⁰⁰
 50 Peterboro at 13⁰⁰ 4⁰⁰ things
 at Morris. 74⁰⁰ Oatmeal \$125⁰⁰ Hewers 74
