Very warm day sunny. Thawing a lot sleighing practically done all wheels mnd. Jno McRee moving down to Ferguson and Behrens moving up to his place. We cut wood etc in A.M. In P.M. I went to Mrs Dardens sale bought cow and harrows. Went in cart with Scott. Sent letter to F.A. re fence post preservative 2

30

Thursday

Cooler to-day cloudy and sunny. snow pretty much gone. We went to Davidsons in A.M. in waygon bought home harrows and cow paid for them \$42.70. In P.M. I drew old manure from hot bed put it around trees then drew load fresh to it. Willie drove Mary downtown in P.M. she took 14 lbs butter to Mrs McVicar @ 21cts \$3.36 Received \$2.36 and 12 lbs to Steels @ 20 240 also 5 doz eggs @ 14 70cts got Sulphur 25 soap 35 yeast cake 10 brown 30 spuds etc 9. onion sets in 100 @ 10 Willie got boots mended etc 80 at McBeth. At Manns castor oil 15 medicine oil 25 in aft.
