Fine sunny warm. Mr Barber got Pouch A M. We plowed turnip land again No 2 tiskit it. I suffed mangels etc PM I also fixed fences. I drove Mary after tea round to Geo Armstrong, Morrisons, Whittens & Jno Armstrong for W.F.M.S. etc. Harry Armstrong had just got back from Toronto where he sold his cattle on a falling market he lost \$250.00 by not selling sooner.

Tuesday

Mostly fine sunny warm looked like rain PM and did rain a few drops. Mr Barber over A M helping load manure We sowed 60 loads on No 3.A. I fixed fences. PM I rolled turnip land and sowed fertilizer on it we drilled up 20 drills. Willie sowed 210 8 drills after tea. Young Alphonse up in morning re headstone. Geo Douglas got land of ditch narrow. The girls went down town PM to see about 40 headstone. Willie drove down for them Lucy in buggy after six Bella came up while we were 50 hitching up and we didn't know it. Lou 40 had 46 fags last night & 25 tonight. The girls got at Shortroads meet 5 fags at Dulcis point etc 95 ds at Stals
