- Oct 19 I went to the river to see what I could get for the  
miserable old plow in the north field south <sup>part of</sup>
- 19 Ad plowed both field finished it this afternoon and  
begin to plow the summer fallow was in dry
- 20 Ad plowed in the summer fallow 3 rows in  
the grasses in the north field where the Rye  
is sowed that needed cleaning a cut
- Nov 21 rain last night Ad had to leave the summer  
fallow & plow in the middle field east line the  
ground is claggy with the rain
- 22 the Rev Mr Stewart preached this morning no make  
at night
- 23 Ad plowed in middle field we drove out some  
big stones took them to east line little way along
- 24 Ad plowed <sup>in</sup> same field fine day
- 25 Do Do
- 26 Ad plowed in the same field Wallace got a horse of  
Mr Darlings & started two plows they both plowed
- 27 finished plowing that field Wallace began in the  
field at the old house Ad plowed same in the  
summer fallow it is so loose he could do with  
so they both plowed at the old house  
I have been shoveling & cleaning out the fire
- 28 Ad & Wallace are both working in the old  
field I cut returned some of the plumb's work then  
there was no meeting to day Mr Bennett died  
not came Mr Tremble is sick
- 30 I went to G. Annapolis with Berice & bought  
home 2 barrels of Satt @ 1.25 per barrel  
100 of the same 2.65 per 100 lbs Ad plowed at home
- 31 Wallace, in the old house field &  
begin to plow the garden & sowed a bush  
of Satt in it a little rain to day growing  
very dry
