- 22 Finished sawing our logs the boys piled it all this fore noon. Jim went to Lunenburg for Murdy. the road is covered with water from McPherson's Martins
- 23 Warm yesterday mercury up to summer heat and.
- 24 Water high in all off.
- 25 I've caught 3-pike. set them
