January 28 continued Thursday Forward  
 in sunshine. Willie went up to Sydney  
 Hamiltons in sleigh (hired) Dan and Kate  
 and brought down cow fauna. I cut wood  
 in hardwood bush. In P.M. we spread 5  
 small loads manure No 7 Linn and Mand in high  
 slipping very thin. Mary down town P.M. got  
 at Russells bridge 20 at Hartman's meat 35  
 Jettison 28 at Phillips 15, goods. Mr. Less over in  
 evening got milk 6ts.

 potatoes etc got fanning mill ready to clean seed oats.  
 A stray dark roan heifer came here last night we put

Very stormy day drifting snowing. frosty.  
 We cleaned seed oats fixed platform scales  
 made box to put on top of fanning mill to hold down  
 grain. Willie drove over to Dix' in morning to  
 see if they owned the roan heifer, they didn't

Very frosty day. Sunny. real winter cold.  
 Mr. Brown preached in A.M. from Acts 4:19,20.  
 and in evening from Luke 15. The parable  
 of the lost sheep. Only Willie and I  
 down at night exceedingly frosty.
