But coincidentally, and not consecutively, the kidneys, liver and lungs undergo damage. This may be due to other things, but it seems to me that in the vast majority of cases it can be traced to the effect of substances that are, or have become, poisonous to the cells; and, furthermore, that these substances are ordinarily derived from proteins taken into the body as food.—L.
