Pattenhouse & wife & 3 little boys to dinner
B's were here too, I & Mary & little ones
went to N B's P.M. W. fine rain this
Morning Showery through the day very
heavy rain this evening we did not get
home from N B's till about sunset
10 Boys ganged in body stubble & cut
