We got back to the farm about four and then went over to Lappe's and got a small bag of hay. It was

after six when we got back with it but as Dad. was home, he helped Frank put it off and I came home. Gadouhy went down with the Lampkin's this afternoon and Mary said she was quite pleased because Mary wanted her to come back Sunday night instead of Monday. Very cold wind all day but milder to night.

Sunday May 3<sup>rd</sup>

We got up late this morning and just did our usual chores in a leisurely way. We had such a late breakfast we didn't have dinner but gave the kids some & put them to sleep. I went to sleep for awhile and then Mary made me get up and shave and proposed going over to see Winnie Shand. Just as we were starting out, the Daughtys & Mrs. Bamford drove in so we didn't go. They hadn't been here long when Mrs. Mearns and Mrs. McLaughlin came in, they brought Mary two very nice little knitted jackets for the babies. We had tea as soon as they left and I helped Mary get the kids to bed so was late getting through with my chores. It takes me quite awhile as I have to milk Bobbie out after I milk the others and feed Nellie's calf. Lovely day to day in spite of cool wind.
