Thunder & lightning this morning heavy rain rained most AM cloudy all day lot from We did sundy jobs to-day & fixed rock etc. We spread load manure from yard No 7 spreader then got big stone on stone boat ready to haul off when ground is little dry.

We paid Wm Armstrong 80⁰⁰ for Japanese fence outlet.

Willie drove Peter Clark down he was to show him man that was buying cows he brought J Mc Kee Willie caught up with him on Gulf road he said he was coming back in two weeks.

Willie got at Armstrong's wife sugar \$1.00 salt 35⁰⁰

Fine sunny day windy cool. We spread 15 loads manure on No 7 today after I feared out to plant after tea. Peter Clark had Lucy to - day harrowing in Tobin place which he has rented. We used Kate just out in box stall Mr Gass over at night milk 5 do. Willie down at night Bella paid on 16th for hat to Miss Battman \$5.00

I went down town at night got at Kinsman paint 25⁰⁰ at Meany's wife take off the hand bell's not worth paid Battman meat 68 got at Phillips Express order for 14.60 for wine £7. M.C. order & postage 12 telegrams 15 Pavels dinner 50 stamp 2 total \$5.39 paid on it #304/11.12 over 43.9.
