I went down town at night got at Kers cream paid 25 at Mennis wife rake of the handle bolts & substitute Paid Battman meat 60 got at Phillips Express order for \$14.60 for wire 2 F.M. Co. order postage 12 helibone 15 Pouches buried 50 stamp 2 total \$15.39 paid on it #30 \$11.12 over 439. Willie got in PM at 7 o'clock bread & beer 16 its
