Wed Sept 11 cloudy and cool I went down to the old place and turned beans for Dick

Thu Sept 12 clear part of the day a heavy rain last night a light shower this afternoon Millie was here doing a little washing for me.

Fri Sept 13 clear most of the day. I went to Johns from there to Dick's from there up home this fore noon. after noon Dick and I went to Florence I went for medicine for myself

Sat Sept 14 cloudy and windy I was helping G. B. Snary cut corn

Sun Sept 15 clear part of the day with high wind

Mon Sept 16 clear with high wind from the West I was helping Dick draw beans the fore part of the day after noon went with Fred Snary to see James Emory who is sick

Camden Gore Broton September

Tue Sept 17 flying clouds high wind and cool Mrs Boyington came back this morning from burring her sister not doing much myself to day.

Wed Sept 18 cloudy and cool. I husk'd corn part of the day Brothe Bilton was here

Thu Sept 19 cloudy part of the day and cool I sett up my corn stalks in the fore noon after noon went with Gerves Paul to the Sem cemenetry at Blackburns

Fri Sept 20 cloudy fore part of the day wet I was helping Mrs Boyington can fruit

Sat Sept 21 clear and windy a frost last night I was helping John cut corn

Sun Sept 22 clear and pleasant

Mon Sept 23 clear and pleasant not doing much in the fore noon. after helping Dick draw draw beans and clover for seed.

Tue Sept 24 clear part of the day and warm not doing much myself to day

Wed Sept 25 clear cool and windy. I split a little
