Rain last night and early morning got very cold  
and frosty by night windy day snow flurries  
at times some sunshine. Willie went up to  
D. Allans A.M. got 350 lbs buckwheat on dp  
I fixed outhouse at passage etc D.M. Hardy  
and Ray came down for their 2 cattle that  
have been here since Friday. We took 8 cattle up  
to Allans no cows. S.D. up P.M. he topped  
turnips and helped load I pulled and trimmed  
most of rest of graystone turnips we got 3 turnip  
box loads in. Willie chopped some.  
D. Allan down in evening got Willie to help him  
get our cattle into his barn yard for the night.  
A lamb died to night we skinned it.  
We got 25 ds from Gus Behrens for milk in advance  
uncle Jim up in A.M. Willie drove him down  
gave him 3 small bag potatoes & bag turnips.
