 Peas this evening. W. fine clear
 22 Took Benjamin to Toronto again Dr says he is
 doing very well G helped Pelky truck boys
 drew 6 loads Peas. Susanna helped to unload
 23 G helped Pelky truck I & boys drew
 8 loads Peas & Mitchell finished pulling W. clear
 24 drew 2 loads Peas. Shower stopped us
 thrashed few Peas A.M. G hoed turnip P.M. W.
 Sunday 25 John & girls went to meeting at Alton
 we went to A.B. W. windy cool
 26 finished drawing Peas 9 loads & 1 load spring
 & wheat raking. W. clear warm
 27 Glaucus & Hermann commenced going to
 school John & Benjamin & G kept house
 G hoed turnips I & Nancy & children went
 to Lindens girls went to Janet McGaw's
 she is married to George Wales W. fine
 28 G ganged fallow I & John drew in
 out raking A.M. I went to Whitevale
 & called at Hoovers Old Man had Paralytic
 stroke yesterday. is rather poorly W. shower
 29 I took Benjamin to Toronto. Dr says his eye is doing
 very well G helped B. N. truck John finished
 ganging fallow. W. very warm clear
 30 G helped B. N. truck A.M. harrowed
 fallow P.M. I & John cleaned seed wheat
 31 I & G helped B. N. truck John ganged
 Pea ground W. rained heavy this evening

Sunday Sept 1 at home ^{Sept} 1878 were here I &
 Nancy went to Hoovers after supper W. very heavy
 in last night & today. Creek running lively
 I & Nancy went to funeral of Christian Barker at
 Edeman's sermon by B. J. Hoover & Mober
 went to Christian Burkholder's P.M. G began
 plowing in Pea ground in fallow W. warm
 round very wet fallow ankle deep in mud
 I & John plowed M. N. wife was here &
 in P.M. W. very warm sultry I went to
 I & John cleaned seed wheat I went to N. Burkholder's
 thresh. Machine didn't come. then he plowed
 all noon. too wet then he & John plowed
 pea ground in root field P.M. J. B. were
 here. W. warm clear
 I & Adeline & Benjamin went to Toronto
 after 19th Eggs 11² & 2 lambs \$5.00. Benjamin's
 eye getting better. W. very sultry & warm
 I & John plowed in fallow, I & Nancy
 Benjamin to J. Lehman's P.M. W. warm clear
 I & John plowed. I chored & went to Cherry wood
 P.M. W. warm clear
 Sunday 8 all went to meeting at Hebron
 remarks by B. C. sermon on St Mat 18 C
 Rev J. B. Barker. Otto Gibson was here
 after service & Gilman W. Clemens at
 supper. W. very sultry & warm
 John & G finished plowing till about 10 o'clock A.M.
 then we drew dung with 2 waggons on pea ground
 we intend to harrow it in with the wheat. W. warm
 harrowed fallow & spread dung I & John
 cleaned seed wheat. W. began to rain about
 I thrashed Peas. W. rain nearly all day
 John brought home load lumber between
 I went home I & John thrashed thrashed Peas A.M.
 went to Cedar Grove P.M. W. rain from east all day
 didn't do much A.M. fixed some board fence
 & blowed down & cut tree that fell across fence
 P.M. went to Cedar Grove this evening. heavy
 rain all A.M. very high water
