- 13 Ad & Wallace drew in 2 loads of hay put them in the New Barn they raked it with a comble rye & went to the funeral of Mrs Bowen ^{she was buried at Mr Conley}
- 14 Ad got a New rake at the Station from 3 ^{Stacey was Mr Nicholson came on the Express} got in 3 loads put one over the Cows & 2 in New born
- 15 I took Mr Nicholson to Fair fax in the morning he preached ^{per at night}
- 16 Ad finished cutting the middle field & began to ^{put hay on the field} the orchard very warm or rather hot day
- 17 Ad finished cutting the orchard got in rain in the afternoon got all the hay out of the North field
- 18 Ad & Wallace got in all the hay from the center field had 3 loads Biron raked in the forenoon they got all in of the orchard had 2 loads Ad then cut the little field North of the house fine day
- 19 very heavy rain last night & this morning Ad & Wallace is haying their potatoes it is no hay day I have done nothing this week my bowels is not weight
- 20 Ad & Wallace finished the haying all but a load
- 21 in the North field fine day
- 21 Ad & Wallace loaded up a load in the North field in the forenoon they are going to take it out to the road they cut Rye in the afternoon ^{Mr Nicholson came on the Express}
- 22 Rev Mr Nicholson preached this morning Mr Conley at night
- 23 Ad & Wallace raked & banded up the Rye I helped to draw it in had 2 loads got it done by noon ^{very warm} they began there haying at the road Mr Nicholson went ^{away on the Express}
- 24 Ad came for the milk this morning I put Paris green on the potatoes very warm day I have to
- 25 finished put the green on the potatoes (pump water ^{from the Cows})
- 26 Ad & Wallace finished there haying at the road & cut their oats in the field next the house & cut part of the Southeast part of the north field
- 27 finished that field & cut part of the old pasture field ^{Ad went to Fenovogge this} ^{partial of wheat in the afternoon}
- 28 rain last night nothing doing I watered the milk shed Mr Nicholson came on the Express Billie came last night
- 29 Rev Mr Conley preached this morning Mr Nicholson at night
- 30 Ad & Wallace came out & cut the wheat in the middle field good crop raked the oats in the North field very poor put it all on the load 10 bushel ^{Ad worked at the road & worked at milk shed in the forenoon} I attended a Congregation meeting ^{Rev Mr Nicholson got a call to be a pastor} ^{Rev Mr Smith & Colman was there}

rain in the morning

Mr Nicholson went home on the Express & Ad took the horse to help him
