P.M. we got 2 loads loads over went back for what was uncovered just as rain was coming the team ran away with Stanley on the small load but got into barn safe Willie went up to Antekomas (Tom) at night to meet M. Donald but didn't see him. Mary and mother went down to stay P.M.

Willie over at Gasses at night.
