Very fine Sacrament at Salem Church in
Sumnerstown Leander to Church 26th
Fine Leander went to Cornwall with the
wool 34 lbs Took home white and grey
yarn 20 cents a lb for wool Bought 3 yds
of cloth for pants 75 a yard Went to
Lancaster got a large picture for the
grading Bought Tea Stanley at fence
I and Jona fishing Perch got 24
Very Warm Rained to night Lightning
The Drudge not Working Broke 27th
Fine Stanley putting a fence out in
the water at the Pitt Point Leander
fixing the Waggon Very Warm
Leander crossed 28th Rained to day Fixing
in the granery put the Wheat in Bags
East Wind took the Boards from up stairs
put them in the granery. 29th Fine North
Wind The Drudge commenced Working
Jonna and Stanley went to Dundee
Took a Tub of Butter my shoe to fix Leander
Ploughing the Potatoes St Peter and St Paul
Bought 1 doz of Cups and saucers 75 cents
Shoe 20 Butter 16 cents 30 lb 4.80 6 Tubs 1.80 5 gal oil 50 Shirting
Tubs 56 Paris green 20 Blacksmith not Paid

James Cameron Island 30th of June 1859
Fine Hoening Potatoes Fishing got 27 Lewis
here fixing the Waggon Last Day June
1st of July J. Johnson Day Windy
Fine Finished the Hoening of Potatoes
Leander crossed The Tilgate Down with
a Party to Valleyfield & Rat Pole
18 Perch 2nd Fine Windy Leander came
from Douquetts Leander to Church 3rd Fine
Began Drawing the sand about 75 Bushels
to day Lewis here for to Shaver to
Jo Douquetts with 1 doz of Eggs Tub of Butter
Jonna and I Fishing Rained to night
English cherries getting Ripe All Hies plenty
4th American Independence Rained fine
Thunder and Lightning and Rain and hail to
night grew some sand Leander for
Paris Green to Sumnerstown 25 cents
5th Uncle John's Birth Day 1803
Fine Thunder put Paris Green on
the East Potatoes 1 Box Stanley went for
another Box 25 Bought a hat 10 2 pipes
1/2 lb of Satts gave him 10 cents
Took up 3 doz of new Potatoes good size
2 year old Heifer calved Leander
Took over a Bag of oats Harry
Thunder Rained hard Lightning
