

Tuesday May 16<sup>th</sup> 1899. wet

we cleaned out sheep pen in morning and fixed calf mangers and hauled gravel to bridge in afternoon Jas Simpson came last night.

Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> wet  
we hauled manure with both teams till about 2 P.M. then we mixed mortar & cleaned out box stalls, & cellar  
W. M. Cray's had cow to Emily

Thursday 18<sup>th</sup> dull  
we hauled gravel in in forenoon to road and hauled manure in afternoon  
J. S. plowing in Lucerne patch in morning.

Friday 19<sup>th</sup> dull  
went to town in morning  
Paid W. Hales for manure <sup>\$9.75</sup> 9.75  
meat <sup>at</sup> \$2.20 meat today. <sup>40</sup> 2.20  
went to see Prof Day about Angus Bull  
<sup>gave</sup> ~~sent~~ a trap or, but 0.5  
35 telegraph poles for <sup>paid</sup> ~~2.00~~ <sup>1.00</sup> 1.00  
to be gathered up on the road  
Geo and J. S. hauled manure all day. I worked at it in afternoon. R. Bruder brought cow to Kymastair

Saturday 20<sup>th</sup> fine  
Geo & Willie took Queen down to Sorby put her to, Lord Channing, J. S. & I spread manure & then started to plow. Geo & I kept at manure & plowing and J. S. plowed road & harrowed orchard
