 & cultivating & I went for
 a load of straw to
 whitelaws & raked 2nd
 grass off. Turnip ground

 Payable at expiration of term

Wednesday 3rd fine
 In on road, with team
 Father cultivating, I chored
 in morning & went to town
 in afternoon, got sugar 2²⁵
 Pd. out on Mortgage \$200,
