 went down in tow of sand Windy raised an old pile
 of sand at Bell Bay that I had piled up over 23
 years and its good yet 31st Went to Chustees Island
 to get Fat Pine seen Birds a Frenchman that
 lives up near Cornwall found a Raven Turned
 Bottom side up Drew it ashore and left it
 high 2 Wind Raising I rowed some got none
 seen some Black snakes Fishermen went to
 Lancaster to night with their Fish 1st of June
 The 3rd Honous First of June Rowena's Birth
 Day 1878. Wind Rain changed to high West Wind from
 the calves pasture fence at the shore pealed an
 Elm for Bark Fishermen Phillip got Bread & cold
 Corsican Late going down 2nd Working at a new calves
 Pasture at the old Garden Fine Day 3rd Fine Windy Algona
 aground above Wells the Slavy and Princess Lorne
 working at her craning at the Shore Landing windy to night
 4th Old George the 3rd Birth Day Ninety Landed
 Raining Went to the Bush got kind of Funer not well
 the Wounded had to stop with the wind Last night
 the algona got away this morning 5th St Bards
 cleaning out the sheds Roubly Raining Here cutting weeds
 out of the Potatoes corn coming up 6th Cropped to summer
 took the sheeps to Hamilton to sharpen John Summers
 wife & young daughter at 4 o'clock this morning B R
 money 20 2 Dollars to small man for labour

 At the Committee's Board on Wed. 25th the Committee
 were 18 in number. The sheep did not call
 with the wind 8th Put the calves in the new pasture
 made a shed for them for the rain but cretches showed the
 sheep Randolph and Rose side crossed got the sheep
 I sent for by Surabeman Lane Randolph a dollar
 for a pair of Boots too small for here. Dinner
 Party at Mr P. Purcells to night as he is
 leaving for the old Country near Thunder
 and lightning to night Rain Randolph sleeping
 with Rose side while Phillip is away
 4th Oxen 140 lbs. Birth Day 1813 let out the sheep
 Windy cutting weeds in Potatoes Ticks Plenty
 some a loss of potatoes. Meeting at Sunnyside
 to night Donald Sanfield 11th
 got 100 lbs of Flour from Montreal
 Kibler took at 4p 3.50 Rain Cold Spang
 the Grey horse out 11th Fine Breeze added
 arrived at home on Grand Barre or Box a Heifer Calve 12th
 Rattle in the Bed from up stairs 13th Went to
 Chester's Island and the Nit Nit Fine 14th at Potatoes
 coming Rose side went with his Fish Bore to Lancaster
 the washing a fine Day 15th 3 Men at the lower Point
 fishing had Fat Pine Firing the Star door Rain Windy
 16th Morning trees in the Grove Randolph to Mr Wards
 Bought of Mr W Ward 5 lbs Sea 25 Soap 1 Hat got
 Papers from the Committee Sent Back two Corns all the
 Cleaning out the shell house Put the Plough through
 the Weeds in the Potatoes and Corn very Warm Rain
 to night heavy Thunder and Lightning the Boys came
 Back from the Barn as they were going to their Bed
 with a heavy clap that came just as they were in 18th
 they have memorable Waterloo. Unicorn went into Dandel
 is Evening for the first time 2 Wind 18 Wind of Rain Thunder Fine cows
 in to night Gate not shut 15th Rain Fine Windy 3 Bore Passed up
 (Boats) and had a Wheel Barrow on the Bow of the Boat
 under lightning at the Garden 17 siding
