Ethel & Hattie went with Hattie Arthur & Hattie came by Hattie Arthur both them to the station at night. Paul came on the morning & went up to the brick. Hattie went home with Arthur & Hattie. Tom & Paul stayed to help butcher the pigs dragging off & on in the forenoon Ethel went to the other house for dinner. I fried a rooster & I dressed it & Arthur was here for dinner. Marjorie went to the mill after bran got 100 for 1.10 sold the eggs at Adams for 85¢ & the butter at Kistner for 28¢ got sugar 25¢ tea 15¢ only set spice 5¢ coal oil 18¢ Mrs Reesing after pepper mint for Hattie she is sick. I made 3 apple pies swept both rooms cleaned the boards. Fred out the rest of the land that was left from yesterday. Sun 14. Quarterly meeting here the ministers went to Hall's. Arthur went with Tom McCreedy to Miller's. Hattie & Mary called in the afternoon just something on their heads it was so warm the weather was out of season one was uncomfortable. Mon 15. wind much east Marjorie went up to Frank's left after the goose. came back by Chippawa got a barrel of salt 1.60 got some more sage I borrowed 24¢ of Paul & all of salt from Wall took the meal all out emptied the barrel & tilled it some more & made pickles cold pickles that would bear an egg had enough to cover all but a little then I churned after dinner. the children guarded the cows on the forenoon then Gordon went to school.
