Another group of cases requiring special post-operative care are the prostatectomies. Here the most active attention is necessary during the first 24 hours to make sure the bladder is draining properly and that the catheter or tube in the bladder is not becoming plugged with clots. As soon as drainage is removed these patients are gotten up in order that they may not become bed ridden. Undoubtedly many patients recover by reason of this forced activity who would not have otherwise done so.—*Balfour; Mayo Clinic. Med. Record.*
