the girths at the house for the Borm

19 went to the outlet to draw lumber got 9 pieces hewed
Bradley C Rath J Johnston & H. Johnston helped

20 went to the outlet & got home 6 pieces of lumber
Stumpson Young helped work day day

21 went to the River & got the rafters 31 pieces from
Nat Webster paid him two dollars for them brought
home in 2 loads A. Cornett helped us to cut a dove

22 the Rev^d W. Robinson preached in the morning
& W. Matthews in the evening

23 Fleming went to Mallerysawn this morning I went
to the outlet & brought home the last load of the
timber Fleming Paciloner & two hands come to
from the Borm. Fleming hewed some of the
rafters in the afternoon

24 finished hewing the rafters very dry & warm

25 went to the Steam mill & got 572 feet of lumber
for studs & braces & brought down one crib
of the logs to the mill they were left a little above
the mill ^{there} drew some stones for the foundation

26 drew the rest of the stones for the foundation

27 Fleming went to his Father's & got 3 bags of oats
& asked hands for the raser I went out
to the mill to see about more sawing warm

28 Fleming went for a load of lumber got 600 feet
I fixed for the foundation in the forenoon
raised this afternoon every thing went well
got a good frame there was 25 hands

29 the Rev^d W. Matthews preached this morning
W. Robinson in the evening

30 Fleming went to the mill for a load of lumber
got 5 feet I went the funeral of a daughter of
Thomas Cornett the Rev^d W. Sutherland preached
in the Ebenezer church there was upwards of
tenns there was such a dust on the road
could not see the team before you some time
