 oats to mill @ 30cts paid for chop 60 balance 40
 Took 1 1/2 bushels oats to Armstrongs traded for oatmeal
 got Scott shoe at Hodge 10 cts brought
 half bag flour from Armstrongs on afe - 5 cts
 didn't get chop done. Willie got 17
 bushels Boranga oats from Dave Allan
 \$25. Jno Knox up for 1 lb butter and
 dog eggs on afe. No sleighing in town
 Willie and Mary down town at night
 Mary stayed down.
