to 3 lbs washing, soda 10, pins 6, 2 1/2 yds print 16
23 cts, Pa. is giving Rue notice to quit
the house

22 Slight showers, not enough to make an
inch in the cistern

23 Dull day, D. B. McLe took tea with us

24 To 2 lbs butter 36 cts

25 Fine day looks like settled weather
Now 9.45 P. M. All our young folk went
to a lawn social at Hugh Fraser 2d Corn
To 1 1/2 lb sausage 15, 2 lbs steak 20. 35

Pa. settled with Rue

26 Fine day There is a picnic at Hamilton
Island Archie Marion & Daisy drove D. Skellern
horse Murphy and B. S. our horse Jimmie took
a wheel. Jimmie Brown and Lizzie remained
at home. To 1 gill coal oil 18 cts, lamp chimney 29
1. 14 butter at M. Crammers & Sugar 25 - 66 took

27. Fine day I was not in church. Pa. is not well F. Robertson
called to see Pa, Susie Foulton & Lilly Snow called
D. B. Mc Lennan & Charlotte were here

28. Very fine day. Lizzie had a letter from Uncle S,
he will not be down this fall Paul the butler
and sugar at M. Crammers and bot 100 of flour 2. 66

29 Another hot day, called at M. Bohomours, got
a big bunch of rhubarb. To stew 21 cts, 10 sugar 52, 71

30 Fine day. To 1 lb tea 30, 4 lb bacon 52 2 lbs butter 80
at Kappman

31. 45 - 10 lb sugar 50 8 yds print 22, 1 spool 4, dish pen 45, puddly 2. 40
