Bessie & Lang down to Deans in AM I took
wood off sheep found dead and buried it. We
got rest of turnip land drilled to-day and
Willie sowed 28 rows after tea with New
Century turnips starting 50 drills from O.D. Jones
Willie and Ernest Byers washed sheep in
PM at Irvine pond E.B. 75 cts sold milk
Behar's 5 cts Willie got N.C. turnip seed last
night at Carlton 50 cts. We left home out tonight

Saturday

Warm sunny day. Willie hauled 3 loads
gravel from Deans to-day. We finished
sowing our turnips to-day I went over
potatoes & corn with weeder. In PM I
plowed some of hilled out clover land in
No 7 stump field. Father up in PM. I
went down town at night paid at Russell's
for 7240 asking for S.D. Robt¹²⁵ express 35
C.O.D 15. \$1.75 got 2 collar & neck tie 60
