Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> fair

Father Inez Grant,  
Willie went to church  
we gave to S. S. I stayed  
at home all day as we was  
expecting Nelly to fail

Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> fine  
Nelly started to fail at 15  
A.M. sent for Dr. Reed about  
eight, we worked till 3 P.M.  
before we got colt away, and  
Nelly died in a few minutes  
J. S. plowing for corn most  
of the day.

Tuesday 23<sup>rd</sup> fine  
Geo & I plowed in manure  
<sup>+ spread</sup> today in morning, and went  
for a load of telegraph poles  
in afternoon. J. S. plowing  
sod all day. Wm. R. from  
Hamilton came up today

Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> fine  
we plowed down manure  
for turnips and cultivated  
corn ground.

Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> <sup>spring</sup> fine  
Geo and J. S. finished  
finished plowing down  
manure, and started  
to roll. I sowed corn  
in afternoon, went to town  
in morning, got corn ~~beans~~  
& axle grease \$2.25 sold hide \$1.75  
got C. oil & whitestone, 50c.

I finished sowing corn  
and Geo. finished rolling  
turnip ground. we both  
cross plowed potato ground in  
afternoon J. S. came back  
& brought. Sat 27<sup>th</sup> wet  
we finished plowing potato  
gnd & put on manure & axle  
in afternoon we washed sheep and  
sorted potatoes
