Wed Aug 3 clear and hot we finished drawing in our oats in the fore noon. William Law helping us after noon helping him draw his

Thu Aug 4 clear part of the day and hot we were repairing fences and drawing wood for thrashing machine I was cutting weed out of the corn. I find it almost impossible up the hot dry weather the crops are going to be very light.

Fri Aug 5 clear fore part of the day latter part cloudy a thunder shower about 4 P.M. we were helping William Law draw

Sat Aug 6 clear high wind from the north and cool we was helping Billton Snary thrash

Sun Aug 7 a hot smokey day.

Mon Aug 8 clear and pleasant we were helping Billton & J. H. Snary thrash.

Tue Aug 9 clear and hot we was helping William Law get out manure in the fore noon, after noon helping Albert Boyington thrash.

Wed Aug 10 clear and hot we was helping Albert Boyington thrash

Thu Aug 11 wet in the morning, not doing much this fore noon, after noon we was helping William Law thrash

Fri Aug 12 clear and pleasant we were helping William Law thrash finished about sun down.

Sat Aug 13 clear fore part of the day cloudy in the evening, I was cutting smut and weeds out of the corn. Walter was drawing up wood.
