Rain & used the Summer Gordon at it
Ground some of the Tools got a
Sturgeon on the Line High N or wind
Water falling 3rd Day 1846
Birth Day 1846 Hard Rain
Gordon crossed to Summerstown
4th Fine cut the corn and
Pulled the Beans Husked
the corn Gordon to Summerstown
5th John Angus 13 Day 1850
Fine gloomy put the Hay in
from the Back Marsh in
the Barn Floor and Stable left
7 washing off the Big stack
in the upper field arguet
here for Butter 6th Fine Day
Made a stack of Marsh Hay
Cut and coiled 40 coils on
out edge of the Marsh Gordon
and John and Stanley 7th Rain
hard Thunder and Lightning East
and West Wind very squally
Cool Water falling shelled the
Beans all that was in the corn 8th
Fine Making north side fence of
the Tobacco John H went to the
Point Leander went for his gun
had 25 cents Lemays came home
narcisse to Butter 1 Dollar

Mr James Cameron Island 9th Sept 1893
Fine put the corn stalks in the
Barn Made a stack of 40 coils
in the Marsh cutting 13 rush in
the upper field The Indian here
for a Dollars worth of Butter
Lewis Bosell passed to the shanty
10th John H and Annie went to
Dundee Fine 4 Men here
from Valleyfield looking
for houses put up their tent
in Bell-Bay one of them Salonda
Cuvett Their names Gordon and
I went up to their tent I created us
wind Raised high from the East
11th Fine Day putting out
manure in the Grove Windy
took in some nuts 12th Fine
Gordon to the Fair in Williamstown
Took up 4 Rows of Potatoes for the
Pigs Boiling them Bacons
Wife here for Butter Narcisse
for Butter Narcisse got
a Dollar John H and Annie
came from Dundee Bought 9
yds of Ticking 1.162 got the Loan
of a Dung fork Heard the Racket
was a ground farm Williamstown
