in the upper field Argent
here for Butter 6th Fine Day
Made a stack of Marsh hay
Cut and coiled 40 coils on
out edge of the Marsh Gordon
and John and Stanley 7th Rain
hard Thunder and Lightning east
and west Wind very squally
cool Water falling shelled the
Beans all that was in the corn 8th
Fine Making north side fence of
the Tobacco John went to the
Point Leander went for his gun
had 25 cents Sonnags came home
narcisse to Butter 1 Dollar

Mr James Cameron Island 9th Sept 1893
Fine put the corn stalks in the
Barn Made a stack of 40 coils
in the Marsh cutting Brush in
the upper field the Indian here
for a Dollars worth of Butter
Lewis Bosell passed to the Shanty
10th John H and Annie went to
Dundee Fine 4 men here
from Valleyfield looking
for grapes put up their tent
in Bell-Bay one of them Salonda
Curvett Their names Gordon and
I went up to their Tent treated us
wind raised high from the East
11th Fine Day putting out
manure in the grove Windy
took in some nuts 12th Fine
Gordon to the fair in Wilton
Took up 4 Rows of Potatoes for the
Pigs Boiling them Bacons
Wife here for Butter Sicias
for Butter Narisse got
a dollar John H and Annie
came from Dundee Bought 8
yds of ticking 1.162 got the loan
of a dung fork heard the Racket
was around Fair in Williamson
